



Step 1 From your computer, click the **Start** menu and double-click the **Control Panel** icon.




If using **Windows Vista** or **Windows 7**, type **mail** into the search box at the top-right of the Control Panel window to quickly find the **Mail** icon. Then, double-click it.



Step 2 Click the **E-mail Accounts** button.



Select **Add a new e-mail account** and click the **Next** button.



Select **IMAP** and click the **Next** button.




Step 6
Enter Your Name and full E-mail Address in the appropriate text boxes. For the Incoming mail server (IMAP), enter mail.example.com and for the Outgoing mail server (SMTP), enter smtp.example.com. Your User Name is your full e-mail address and your Password is your email password. Check the box to Remember password if you do not wish to enter the password each time when accessing your e-mail account. When you are complete, click the More Settings



Step 7 In the new window that opens, click the **Outgoing Server** tab at the top.



Step 8 Check the box for **My outgoing server (SMTP) requires authentication** and ensure that **Use same settings as my incoming mail server** is selected. Click the **Advanced** tab to configure additional settings.


Enter port 993 in the text box after Incoming server (IMAP).

Check the box for This server requires an encrypted connection (SSL).


Enter port 465 in the text box after Outgoing server (SMTP).

Check the box for This server requires an encrypted connection (SSL).


Click the **OK** button when finished.
