Relay Indiana

Deaf, Hard of Hearing and Speech Impaired Services

The Indiana Telephone Relay Access Corporation (InTRAC) offers Relay Indiana, a free service that provides people with hearing, speech, or other disabilities full access to telecommunications. Using InTRAC, users with special telecommunication devices can communicate with standard users through specially trained Relay Operators. The service also provides free, loaned equipment for those who qualify.

This service relays calls between a person using a text telephone (TT/TTD) and users of the general telephone network in the State of Indiana.
