FRS Youth Tour Program Guidelines

Purpose:

Eligibility:

To be eligible for the FRS Youth Tour a student must meet the following requirements:

- Live with their parent or legal guardian who maintains their primary residential service with Endeavor Communications* in one of the exchanges listed below.
- The student must maintain at least a "C" grade point average.
- The student must be either 16 or 17 years of age on the day of the tour.

How to Apply:

Required materials must be submitted to Endeavor Communications by March 17, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.

- To be considered, applicants must submit a completed application form. The application can be found in this document. You may also obtain application copies at the Endeavor Communications general offices in Cloverdale, Indiana.
- Applicants must attach a current photograph to the application.
- Trip winners will be required to attend the Endeavor Communications Annual Meeting. Winners will be notified by phone.

FRS Youth Tour winners will be determined by submitted applications of all eligible applicants.
